About the PV24 Construction Management Course

We look at key skills and focus areas that are beneficial in the lifespan and management of any project, including construction projects, that has a defined duration.

The focus is on three distinct time frames within the life cycle of a construction project (preparation, planning and execution) with each section consisting of four modules.

All modules are set up with two mini projects, being a Subsoil Drainage System and Concrete Lined Open Drains as the backdrop on a real project.

Contract Documents (Module 1.3) is the third of twelve modules and forms part of the preparation phase of the construction project life cycle.

What is this course made up of?

Following the videos covering introduction there is an overview of various documents that make up of the construction contract.

The focus shifts to construction drawings including an overview and look at various types of drawings issued during the lifespan of project before an in depth look at the specification.

The Specifications covers an in depth focus into both the COTO Specification and the SANS 1200 Specification. This is based on individual Bill of Quantities that have been set up for each of the two mini projects. Each step in the construction of the structures for the mini projects as identified in the Work Sequence (1.1) is matched to the relevant portion of the specification.

Focus areas within the specifications include the overall working of the specification, the Requirements for Construction of each item within the Bill of Quantities, Measurement and Payment of each item within the Bill of Quantities, and Preliminary and General entitlement as defined in the Specification.

The course presentation is included as a free download which can be printed and used for making individual notes and adding comments.

The access duration for completion is six weeks and successful conclusion of the course will earn 1.0 CPD Point.

Who should attend?

Any construction professional who is employed within the built environment.

What is the expected Outcome of the course?

Understand the key documents that makes up the contract.

Identify different types of drawings as used in construction projects.

Fully understand the workings of the Specification specially for the Work to be performed, Measurement and Payment of the work and entitlement relating to Preliminary & General items.
