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E-learning Course

About the PV24 Construction Management Course

We look at key skills and focus areas that are beneficial in the lifespan and management of any project, including construction projects, that has a defined duration.

The focus is on three distinct time frames within the life cycle of a construction project (preparation, planning and execution) with each section consisting of four modules.

All modules are set up with two mini projects, being a Subsoil Drainage System and Concrete Lined Open Drains as the backdrop on a real project.

Resources (Module 2.2) is the sixth of twelve modules and forms part of the planning phase of the construction project life cycle.

What is this course made up of?

After the introductory videos the focus quickly shifts to identifying the required resources and building the resource schedule for each mini project based on the activity and outcome identified in the Work Sequence (1.1).

The focus areas are as follows:

- Introduction into Resources
- Basic Resource List
- Complex Resources
- Building Teams
- P&G Resources
- Coding Resources

The course presentation is included as a free download which can be printed and used for making individual notes and adding comments.

The access duration for completion is three weeks and successful conclusion of the course will earn 0.7 CPD Points.

Who should attend?

Any construction professional who is employed within the built environment.

What is the expected Outcome of the course?

The main aim of this module is to identify required resources and compile a comprehensive resource schedule that will be utilised when pricing the work in the Bill of Quantities.
